

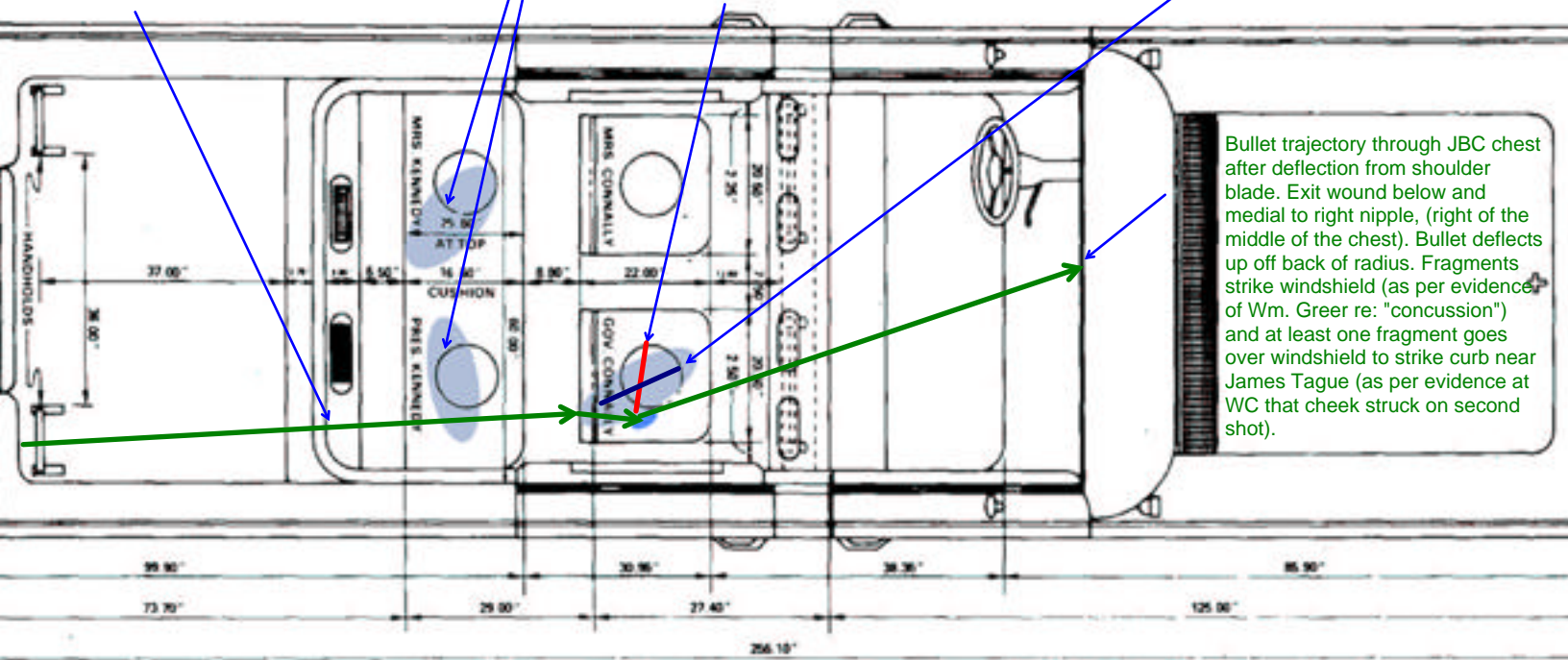
Direction of second bullet: 3 degrees to car horizontal and 10 degrees vertical from TSBD 6th floor.  
 Bullet passes over JFK's right shoulder and causes hair on right side to fly up (as per SA Hickey and SA Kinney). Bullet drops 4 inches over 24 inch distance between JFK and JBC. With JFK leaning over back of jump seat, bullet goes on to strike JBC in right armpit striking fifth rib.

JFK has moved to left and Jackie moved to right, her left hand reaching to JFK's right forearm.

Direction of JBC's hips - facing toward front, turned slightly right

Direction of the shoulders and head. Shoulders are turned more than chest as hips face forward.

Bullet trajectory through JBC chest after deflection from shoulder blade. Exit wound below and medial to right nipple, (right of the middle of the chest). Bullet deflects up off back of radius. Fragments strike windshield (as per evidence of Wm. Greer re: "concussion") and at least one fragment goes over windshield to strike curb near James Tague (as per evidence at WC that cheek struck on second shot).
